THE GAME: 7 p.m., Friday, Wichita Falls Memorial Stadium.

THE SERIES: Martin leads the series, winning the only match-up, 56-35, in last season's area playoff at Wichita Falls.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Martin was the champion of 4-6A and is the top Division I seed from that district. Amarillo finished second in 2-6A, and is their top Division I seed.

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD: Martin set a new Arlington ISD record for points in a playoff game last week by demolishing Midland, 76-18. The 76 points topped the previous mark of 70, set by Arlington in the Colts' 70-42 win over Odessa on Nov. 20, 2009.

AGAINST THE BEST: Martin was 5-2 against this year's playoff teams, beating DeSoto, Bowie, Lamar, Arlington and Midland, and losing to South Grand Prairie and Dallas Skyline. Amarillo was 6-2, beating El Paso Montwood (twice), Midland, Abilene Cooper, Lubbock Monterey and Amarillo Tascosa, and losing to Wichita Falls Rider and Wolfforth Frenship.

THE GAME: 7 p.m., Friday, Odessa's Ratliff Stadium.

THE SERIES: This will be the first meeting between Lamar and Eastwood. Lamar's only previous game against an El Paso school was a 49-7 win over El Paso Andress in the 1990 Division I Regional final at Texas Stadium.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Lamar finished second was in 4-6A and is the top Division II seed from that district. The Vikings' 10 wins are their most since 2003. El Paso Eastwood finished third in District 1-6A and is the lower Division II seed.

THE WAIT IS OVER: Eastwood's win last week was its first playoff win since 1999. The Troopers had lost three consecutive playoff games before last week.

AGAINST THE BEST: Lamar was 3-1 against this year's playoff teams, beating Bowie, Arlington and Midland, and losing to Martin. Eastwood was 4-2, beating El Paso Chapin, El Paso Bel Air, El Paso El Dorado and Wolfforth Frenship, and losing to El Paso Americas and El Paso Montwood.
