ARLINGTON ISD – WEEK SEVEN PREVIEW

DISTRICT 4-6A

 **Sam Houston Texans (1-4, 0-2) at**  **Arlington Colts (3-2, 2-0)**

7 p.m. Thursday at UTA's Maverick Stadium

THE SERIES: The Colts lead the city's oldest rivalry, 32-13-3, and have won nine of the last 10. Arlington also owns a 11-3-1 advantage at Maverick Stadium, where the Texans haven't beaten Arlington since 1999.



LAST WEEK: Arlington routed North Crowley, 49-20, while Sam Houston fell short to Martin, 26-16.

THREE OF A KIND: Arlington High has not been 3-0 in district play since 2008.

HAT TRICK: Arlington receiver D'Montae Davis tied the Arlington ISD record last week by catching three touchdown passes in a game. Davis is the 17th AISD player to accomplish the feat.

THE SERIES: Bowie leads the series, 5-0, including the only previous meetings at Wilemon Field.

LAST WEEK: Bowie fell from the unbeaten ranks in District 4-6A after losing to Lamar, 30-23, while North Crowley lost Arlington, 49-20.

RUNNING WILD: Bowie senior DeAndre Cook set the school's single-game rushing record last week with a 311-yard effort against Lamar. The previous record was 276 yards, set by Steve Franke against Burleson in 1980.

THE SERIES: The Warriors lead the series, 10-1, and have won the last eight meetings. The teams have split the two meetings at Maverick Stadium.

LAST WEEK: Martin remained atop the district standings with a 26-16 victory over Sam Houston, while Weatherford leveled its district record at 1-1 after topping Fort Worth Paschal, 27-26.

GAMES THAT MATTER: Martin, who is going for its fourth straight 3-0 start in district, has now won 11 consecutive district games, tying the Warriors for the fifth-longest district winning streak in AISD history.

THIS PLACE LOOKS FAMILIAR: Martin returns to Maverick Stadium for its first regular-season home game since Nov. 5, 1993, a 27-20 loss to Irving Nimitz. The Warriors played at Maverick Stadium from 1986-93, before moving to Cravens Field. Martin was the home team at a playoff game at Maverick Stadium on Nov. 26, 2010, a 42-21 loss to Euless Trinity.
