 ***Mansfield Summit Jaguars (6-0, 3-0) at***  ***Juan Seguin Cougars (4-2, 1-2)***

7 p.m. Thursday, Wilemon Field

THE SERIES: Summit leads the Catfight Series, 4-1, although the teams have split the two games at Wilemon Field.

LAST WEEK: Seguin posted its top score of the season, but still ended up on the short end of a 51-41 decision to Mansfield Legacy, while Summit edged Waxahachie, 43-42.

IN THE ZONE: Seguin's Daniel Owoyele set a school record last week with five touchdowns against Legacy. Three other Cougars had scored four in a game.

DISTRICT 4-6A

 ***Lamar Vikings (5-1, 2-1) at***  ***Arlington Colts (4-2, 3-0)***

7:30 p.m., Friday, UT-Arlington's Maverick Stadium

THE SERIES: The Vikings lead the series, 24-19-1, but the Colts own a thin 8-7 edge at Maverick Stadium, where Lamar hasn't won since 2006.



LAST WEEK: Lamar crushed Fort Worth Paschal, 56-7, while Arlington routed Sam Houston, 49-21.

THE RARE DOUBLE: Arlington's Alan Braxton and Kenland McCray both rushed for more than 200 yards last week against Sam Houston, making them the first teammates in Arlington ISD history to each rush for 200 yards in the same game. Their 422 combined yards are the fourth-highest total by two teammates in city history.

FOUR ON THE FLOOR?: A win this week would make Arlington High 4-0 in district play for the first time since 2008.

THE SERIES: The Warriors lead the series, 15-8, and have won four of the last five.



Martin has also captured seven of the 10 meetings at Cravens Field.

LAST WEEK: Martin remained atop the stack in District 4-6A with a 53-20 thumping of Weatherford, while Bowie thrashed North Crowley, 63-7.

STREAKING: Martin's win last week was its 12th consecutive district win, the fifth-longest streak in Arlington ISD history. A win this week would match Sam Houston's 13-game streak from 1975-77, the fourth-longest streak.

 ***Fort Worth Paschal Panthers (3-3, 0-3) at***  ***Sam Houston Texans (1-5, 0-3)***

7:30 p.m., Friday, Wilemon Field

THE SERIES: The Texans lead the series, 9-2, and have won the last five. The Texans have won four of the five meetings at Wilemon Field, where the Panthers have not won since 2008.

LAST WEEK: Sam Houston fell to Arlington High, 49-21, to remain winless in district play, while Paschal was crushed by Lamar, 56-7. The Panthers have allowed 140 points in their three district games.

REPEAT PERFORMANCE?: It would be hard for Sam Houston to match last year's effort against Paschal. The Texans set their single-game scoring record with 75 points, and also set an Arlington public schools record with 691 yards rushing.

STILL LOOKING: Sam Houston has not been 0-4 in district play since 2008.
