DISTRICT 4-6A

 **Colleyville Heritage Panthers (2-1) at**  **Bowie Volunteers (0-2)**

7:30 p.m. Friday, Wilemon Field

THE SERIES: Bowie leads the series, winning the only previous meeting, 45-34, last year at Mustang-Panther Stadium in Grapevine. This will be the first meeting at Wilemon Field.

LAST WEEK: Bowie enjoyed a week off after absorbing a 28-17 loss to Cedar Hill two weeks ago. Colleyville Heritage improved to 2-1 with a 42-28 win over Lake Highlands. The Panthers also have a 35-21 loss to Abilene and a 27-0 victory over Grapevine.

STILL LOOKING: Bowie is still looking for its first win of the season. The Volunteers have not been 0-3 since 2005.

DISTRICT 14-5A

 **Juan Seguin Cougars (3-0) at**  **Mansfield Timberview Wolves (2-1)**

7:30 p.m. Friday, Mansfield's R.L. Anderson Stadium

THE SERIES: Timberview leads the series, 2-1, but Seguin has won the only previous meeting at R.L. Anderson Stadium.

LAST WEEK: The Cougars improved to 3-0 for the first time in school history with a 30-12 win over Dallas Carter on Saturday. Timberview picked up its second win of the season with a wild, 44-37 decision over Waco Midway. The Wolves own a 34-17 win over Midlothian, but dropped their opener to Ennis, 33-28.

DISTRICT OPENER: This is the opening week of district action in 14-5A. Seguin is 4-7 in district openers and has lost its last three. The Cougars fell to Timberview last year and Ennis in 2012 and 2013. Timberview is 6-5 in district openers and has won its last three, beating Seguin last year and Grand Prairie in 2012 and 2013.
